MS. PERUGINI: Thank you, Chair Wright. Good morning. This is Sara Perugini.

Item No. 1 in your packet, which starts on page 4 of the PDF, is a Memo and Resolution for Freeport Regional Health Care Foundation, who is the Borrower. The Memo and Resolution detail amendments the Borrower would like to make to its Series 2014 A and Series 2014 B bonds and accompanying documents.

The Series 2014 bonds were issued pursuant to two separate bond trust indentures. All of the Series 2014 bonds currently bear interest in an index rate period ending August 30th, 2021. Fifth

Third Bank holds all of the Series 2014 A bonds, and U.S. Bank National Association holds all of the Series 2014 B bonds.

As the initial index rate period is about to end, the Borrower is converting the interest rate on the Series 2014 bonds so they will bear interest in a term rate period. As of today, the term is expected to be anywhere between 7 to 10 years at a rate of approximately 2 to 2.3 percent respectively, and the Borrower expects that Fifth Third Bank Commercial Funding Inc. will purchase and hold all of the Series 2014 A bonds for the new term and that Wintrust Bank will purchase and hold the Series 2014 B bonds for the new term.

In connection with the conversions, the Borrower and the new banks would like to amend certain terms in the bond indentures. The banks will approve such amendments. The proposed Authority Resolution approves supplements to the bond indentures and certain other documents necessary to implement the amendments. The amendments may result in the bonds being treated as reissued for tax purposes.

Chapman & Cutler LLP is expected to

provide an opinion that the amendments will not adversely affect the tax-exempt status of any of the Series 2014 bonds. The Authority's estimated fee and the Borrower's financials are also included. The Peer Review Committee recommends approval.

Item No. 2 on page 14 of your Conduit packets is a Memo and Resolution on behalf of Lawrence Hall, formally known as Lawrence Hall Youth Services, which is located in north Chicago.

Lawrence Hall and Wintrust Bank, as the proposed new bond purchaser, are requesting approval of a Resolution to, No. 1, authorize the execution and delivery of a first amendment to the bond and loan agreement, and No. 2, approve related documents to effectuate a remarketing of the Series 2014 bonds to Wintrust Bank while also resetting the interest

rate period -- interest rate, extending the initial interest period and accelerating certain principal payments in connection with the Authority's outstanding Series 2014 bonds issued for the benefit of Lawrence Hall.

On August 12th, 2014, the Authority issued its Series 2014 bonds in the aggregate principal amount of \$12.1 million which was purchased in whole by Fifth Third Bank for an initial term of approximately seven years, otherwise ending next month, September 1st, 2021.

Just for some background, proceeds of the Series 2014 bonds were used by the borrower to refund the Authority's Series 2006 bonds previously issued for Lawrence Hall. Proceeds of the Series 2006 bonds were used to finance, refinance, and reimburse the Borrower all or a portion of the cost of the acquisition, construction, renovation, improvement, and equipping of its residential treatment center which was placed in service on March 1st, 2008, and is located at 4833 North Francisco Avenue on the north side of Chicago.

Comprised of three series, the 2014 A bond is bearing a variable rate of interest based on

LIBOR while the 2014 B bond and the Series 2014 C bond each bear a fixed rate of interest that is between 2.5 percent and 3 percent. As of August 1st this year, the outstanding aggregate principal amount of the Series 2014 bonds was approximately \$9.5 million. Principal on the outstanding Series 2014 bonds has been payable each November 1, and the final maturity date is November 1, 2038.

Approval of this Resolution will provide consent to changes as agreed to by the Borrower and Wintrust Bank concerning the Series 2014 bonds.

While also remarketing the Series 2014 bonds from Fifth Third Bank to Wintrust Bank, the Borrower and its new bond purchaser also desire to apply a fixed rate of interest of the Series 2014 A bond replacing the old structure, which was a variable interest rate, and decrease the fixed rate of interest borne on the Series 2014 B bond and Series 2014 C bond. Each series of the 2014 bonds will then carry this new fixed rate.

The Borrower and bond purchaser have agreed to an initial term of approximately seven years otherwise ending September 1, 2028.
